Rosa Parks

(1913-2005) Born in America

She was sent to jail for standing up for what she believed in.

Eventually the **law changed** because of Rosa and her friends had show that it was not right to treat people differently because of the colour of their skin.

(1997)

Born in Pakistan

In 2007, the <u>Taliban</u> made a law that girls could no longer go to school. Malala thought that this was not right and continued to go to school.

She spoke against the law telling others that **she would go** to school and that **school is for everyone**.

In 2012 The <u>Taliban</u> found out what Malala had been saying She was shot but survived.

Her and her family moved to England and when she recovered she continued to fight for everyone's right for education

In 2014 Malala won the **Nobel Peace prize**
