

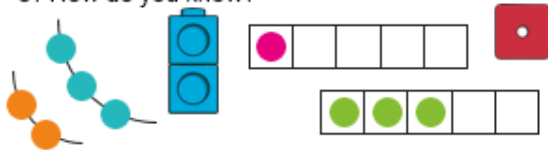
# Our topic this half term is: Once upon a time

Elijah has sorted some objects into the hoops. Has he done this correctly? How do you know? Would you move any of the objects to a different hoop?

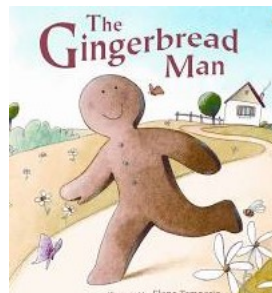
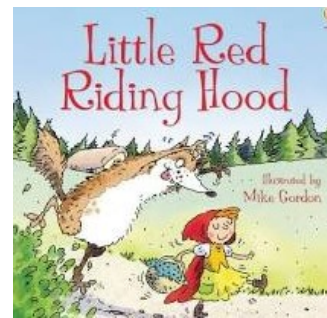
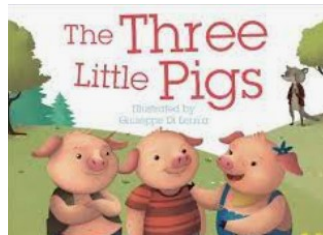


## Compare Amounts

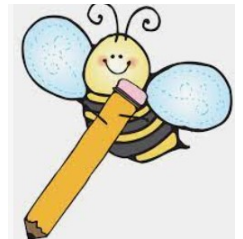
